SEMI-Annual Proposal

Las Vegas Proposal #1
By-laws change in wording, section 6.1, paragraph 3 - amend by striking out "and serve for a term of 2 year".
PASSED

Las Vegas Proposal #2

Place the hosting of the NPA Annual and Semi-Annual back in the hands of local chapters. FAILED

Las Vegas Proposal #3

NPA should consider making a modest contribution to the Amistad Organization on the campus of Tulane University on an annual basis. FAILED

Las Vegas Proposal #4

By-laws change in wording, amend section 5.11, by striking out "Executive Committee" and insert "Board of Directors". Strike out "receipt of written" and insert "Acceptance of written". PASSED

Las Vegas Proposal #5

Authorization of rooms comped or at cost to NPA shall not be given without prior consent of EC, number of rooms to be revealed to EC before authorization given. FAILED

Las Vegas Proposal #6

Theft of NPA funds/monies a 5 year suspension restitution of funds/monies reinstatement must be approved by majority of membership. PASSED

Las Vegas Proposal #7

All infraction shall be resolved in 30 days of the infraction.

PASSED

Las Vegas Proposal #8

We propose the following change to the criteria for the Player of the year. Change the sentence- The committee will announce the Player of the Year results at the MLK tournament business meeting held in January, to the committee will announce the Player of the Year results in

the Gazette newsletter in the January edition. PASSED

Las Vegas Proposal #9

The R&E Committee propose the following addition to the criteria for the Plaver of the Year. Add: If two members have the same total Player of the Year points at the end of the sanctioned tournament calendar year, total scores for each sanctioned tournament participated in will be added together to determined which member has the highest score total. The member with the highest score total will be declared the Player of the year. **PASSED**

Las Vegas Proposal #10

We propose the following addition to the Hall of Fame Criteria, Add: If two or less nominations are received by the Hall of Fame Committee. the nominations will be submitted to the Board of Directors for a vote at the Semi **Annual Tournament and Convention to determine if** individuals should be inducted into the Hall of Fame. A 70% approval of the Board of Directors will be needed to approve these types of inductions into the Hall of Fame. PASSED

INSPIRATION

Read: James 3:1-12 and Leviticus 19-20; Matthew **27:51-66**

From Vietnamese pot-bellied pigs to Siberian foxes, humans have learned to tame wild animals. People enjoy teaching monkeys to "act" in commercials or training deer to eat out of their hands. As the apostle James put it, "Every kind of beast and bird, of reptile and creature of the sea, is tamed and has been tamed by mankind" (3:7). But there is something we

cannot tame. All of us have trouble getting a little thing called the tongue under control. "No man can tame the tongue," James tells us (v.8). Why? Because while our words may be on the tip of our tongue, they originate from deep within us. "Out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks" (Matt. 12:34). And thus the tongue can be used for both good and evil (James 3:9). Or, as scholar Peter Davids put it, "On the one hand, [the tongue] is very religious, but, on the other, it can be most profane." If we cannot tame this unruly tongue of ours, is it destined to be a daily problem for us, always prone to speak evil? (v.10). By God's grace, no. We are not left to our own devices. The Lord will "set a guard" over my mouth; He will "keep watch over the door of my lips" (Ps. 141:3). He can tame the untamable.

Lord, my mouth sometimes speaks words that don't honor You. Thank You that by Your Spirit my untamed tongue can be brought under divine control. Please guard my mouth today.

To rule your tongue, let Christ rule in your heart.
