REMINDERS

1. Deadline for membership renewal was December 1, 2013. Any members not renewed by

December 14, 2013 will not be able to play in the January MLK tournament in Louisville.

- 2. Renewals received after January 30, 2014 will require recertification (payment of \$25.00 plus \$20.00 per member).
- 3. Chapter vote for location of 2014 annual should be submitted as soon as possible.

PINOCHLE TIPS AND RULES

- 1. There are no set rules on how to play a hand. Remember each hand is different.
- 2. All the cards are dealt to you and vou discover the wrong person dealt. You should throw the cards in and the correct person deals.
- 3. A player may request to 'see' the last closed book 'Before' the 1st card of the next book is played. Only the player that requested to 'see' the book may change their card to prevent a forced renege. There can be no discussion during the review of the book; i.e., 'What's trump?' 'Who played what?' or 'What lead?' etc.
- 4. Give lead backs whenever possible so your partner has

more options on how to play the hand.

5. Always practice and play using the correct NPA tournament rules and point/meld count.
