Frequently Asked Questions

What travel documents are required?

If sailing from a United States port to the Caribbean, Bahamas, Bermuda, Canada/New England, Hawaii, Alaska, Panama Canal and Mexico, you MUST have a valid United States or Canadian passport. Exceptions: United States citizens on cruises that begin and end at the same port in the United States can use an original government-issued picture ID (i.e. driver's license) AND an original government-issued birth certificate or original Naturalization Certificate. Minors under the age of 16 will be able to present either an original government-issued, original or certified copy of his or her birth certificate; a Consular Report of Birth Abroad issued by DOA; or Certificate of Naturalization issued by United States Citizenship and Immigration Services. Note: Baptismal papers and hospital certificates of birth are NOT acceptable. Military identification cards, voter registration cards or Social Security cards are NOT considered proof of citizenship. No refunds will be given to individuals who fail to bring proper documentation at check-in.

Are there any COVID related requirements?

The cruise line recommends that fully vaccinated guests carry their Vaccination Record Cards because businesses in some ports may ask you to present it. Also, testing requirements vary by port of departure and vaccination requirements. The cruise line will advised of the latest requirements for its port of departure before sailing.

Is travel insurance available?

You can purchase travel protection through Royal Caribbean to cover circumstances such as a family member getting sick or hurt and you are unable go on your cruise vacation, your flight to the cruise is delayed, your bags are lost/stolen/damaged, you get sick or hurt on your trip, or need an emergency medical evacuation. Travel protection will cover you.

What are the requirements for guests with disabilities traveling alone on a Royal Caribbean cruise ship?

Royal Caribbean does not require that a guest with a disability travel with another person as a condition for traveling on their ships. However, Royal Caribbean personnel are not required to perform personal tasks (e.g. assisting with eating, dressing, toileting or lifting and therefore, guest requiring assistance with these functions should consider these needs when booking the cruise.). For information on mobility equipment rentals, please contact your cruise coordinator.

What is cost for single occupancy?

Unfortunately, the cost for a single person will be double the price shown for the first and second guests. For the categories listed, the single rates are as follows: $4V - \$2,493.80 \cdot 4N - \$3,513.60 \cdot 1N - \$3,713.60 \cdot 4D - \$3,813.60 \cdot 3D - \$4,173.60$

What is the group's cancellation policy?
