"ARTICILE I- NAME

The name of the organization shall be NATIONAL PINOCHLE ASSOCIATION, INC., hereinafter referred to as NPA or Corporation.

ARTICIE II- PURPOSE

NPA shall be a non -profit charitable Corporation organized under Section 501(c)(7) of the Internal Revenue Code of 5954 and is subject to any future applicable provisions of the United States Internal Revenue Code(s).

NPA is organized to promote the game of pinochle by:

Fostering the spirit of good fellowship in the game of Pinochle, offering guidance and supervision to NPA membership organizations, adapting and implementing uniform playing rules and regulations, assisting local Chapters who host individual tournaments and furthering the enjoyment of the game of Pinochle by all its members.
